Erik's business career includes work as an attorney with Faegre Baker Daniels (formerly Faegre & Benson); as a Senior Vice President of commercial and corporate banking with U.S. Bank; Vice Chair and COO for a \$5 billion family holding company with more than 300 separate and diverse companies; and as an investor and entrepreneur.

A member of the Barbershop Harmony Society since 1992, Erik sang with the twice-honored international silver medalist Great Northern Union chorus, where he held multiple board positions and roles. Erik has two children, Siri (21), a senior at the University of California Berkeley, and Adin (19), also a barbershopper, sophomore at Purdue University and member of the Purdue Varsity Glee Club.
