brave?

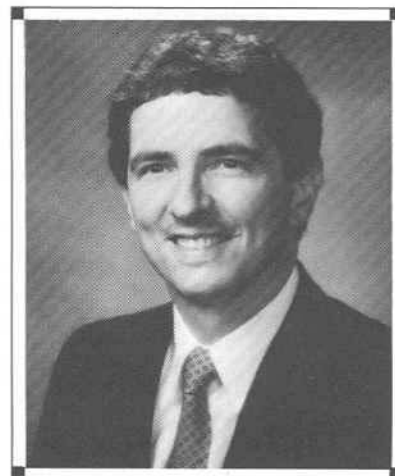
