His first five years have been spent building effective partnerships with leading music education organizations; energizing the relationship with the philanthropic Harmony Foundation International; harnessing the power of thousands of man hours of volunteers; and placing the Society on a solid financial footing that positions it for significant growth investments. A comprehensive strategic plan encompassing all phases of mission, marketing, technology and philanthropy is now underway by his direction, building on these core assets.

Marty joined the Society in 1984 as a member of the Old Capital Chorus in Iowa City, Iowa. He later became a member of the International silver medalist Great Northern Union chorus. While in the Minneapolis area, Marty and his wife, Amy, participated in the founding of Paideia Academy, a K-8 public charter school in Apple Valley, MN.
