



The Roadrunners Quartet was organized in September, 1963. In October, 1963 they were chosen as the Cardinal (Ind.-Ky.) District Champions. Since that time, they have been one of the two quartets to represent the Cardinal District in the International Quartet contest in San Antonio, Texas in 1964; Boston, Mass. in 1965; and Chicago, Ill. in 1966.

The Roadrunners have traveled extensively in the Midwest in the three and a half years they have been organized and have made over 350 appearances before the smallest of banquets or business meetings to audiences of over 8,000 people. Although the quartet is relatively new, is members have a total of over 70 years of quartet singing experience.
