Consider these **Top 10 reasons to sign up today for *The Great Reunion!***

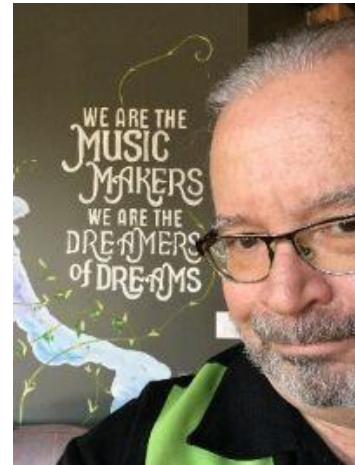
10. A city with life happening and a hotel with convention facilities — remember those?

Book your hotel room today!

Pioneer District's fall convention will be located at the Radisson Hotel in downtown Kalamazoo. Showcases and quartet contests will be in the ballroom, and all of the hospitality rooms that we typically enjoy at the Radisson will be available as well.

Please note there are fewer rooms available at the Radisson due to renovations; we only have 90 instead of our usual 180. Discover Kalamazoo has secured rooms at three overflow hotels: Avid, Candlewood Suites and Fairfield Inn East. All are in the Sprinkle Road/I-94 area.

We suggest booking soon. Rooms may fill up quickly, with Western Michigan University and Kalamazoo College homecoming football games happening the same weekend). Most hotels will allow a 24-hour cancellation with no penalty, but be sure to check when reserving your room.

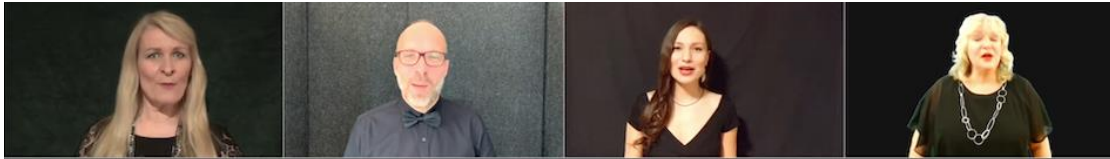
Avid - Call (269) 488-7073 and ask for the Barbershop Harmony Society group rate. (Online link not available at Troub publication time.) Rate: \$119/night
